EATON residents will have the opportunity to either sink their teeth into an exciting 'mystery' novel or a delicious teal-coloured cupcake this month to help raise funds for ovarian cancer, thanks to local business TerryWhite Chemmart Eaton.

TerryWhite Chemmart Eaton will be selling 'mystery' books for a gold coin donation during the month of February. Staff members are donating pre-loved books, which will be concealed in brown paper, with only a short description of the mystery book on the back cover. Books will be available from the front counter.

The pharmacy has also teamed up with Café Merchant to sell teal-coloured cupcakes for \$5. The cupcakes will be for sale at Café Merchant at Eaton Fair (opposite TerryWhite Chemmart Eaton).

Members of the community can also purchase raffle tickets for a gold coin donation, to win a \$100 note.

All proceeds from the books and raffle tickets will go to Ovarian Cancer Australia. Part of the proceeds of the cupcakes will go to the charity.

"Ovarian cancer affects so many people - we just want to do what we can to help out," said TerryWhite Chemmart Eaton retail manager Chantelle Skinner.

The most common reported symptoms are increased abdominal size or persistent abdominal bloating, abdominal or pelvic (lower tummy) pain, feeling full after eating a small amount, or needing to urinate often or urgently.
